

JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

Order Setting Deadline for Filing Late Appeal Requests
For 2021 Reassessment Cycle Appeals

Whereas, pursuant to the authority granted under Missouri Revised Statutes, sections, 137.385, St. Louis County v. State Tax Commission, 529 S.W. 2d 384 (Mo. S.Ct. 1975) and Lake St. Louis Community Association v. State Tax Commission, 759 S.W.2d 843 (Mo. S.Ct. 1988), the Board acknowledged that the statutory appeal deadline was to be July 12, 2021.

Since that time, the Board has considered requests for a late appeal from various taxpayers. The Board has given full consideration to any owner or taxpayer who could show good cause for missing the appeal deadline and who filed a late appeal request. The Board has provided ample time to have any appeal filed for the 2021 reassessment cycle.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:


The deadline for filing any request for a late appeal for the 2020 reassessment cycle to the Jackson County Board of Equalization shall be September 30, 2021.


