

CHECKLIST FOR SEASONAL SALES PERMITS
(Nine per year at temporary sites)

- Application by a non-profit organization, individual, partnership, corporation or wholesale distributor **signed and dated**.

- Non-profit organization** must be in compliance with section 144.083 and Chapter 320, RSMo:
 - a. Tax Exempt Statement from State of Missouri
 - b. Permit from Missouri Division of Fire Safety
 - c. Proposed Use of Proceeds from Sales – Statement from officer of the non-profit organization to include percentage of profits **signed and dated**.
 - d. Rental agreement

- Retail/Wholesale:** Current Missouri Retail Sales License and Fireworks Permit from Missouri Division of Fire Safety.

- Must be in compliance with State tax laws:
Proof: Certificate of No Tax Due from the State of Missouri and Tax Clearance from the Collector of Jackson County, Missouri)

- Proof of Insurance: Certificate of Liability Insurance to include insured’s name and location.

- Zoning compliance:
Statement from Jackson County Public Works with maps

- ◆ Retail – Nine (9) Permits issued per year at temporary sites

- Retail Location Fee of \$750.00:
 - Two Money Orders or Checks payable to: Mary Jo Spino, County Clerk
 - One in the amount of \$150.00 (non-refundable)
 - One in the amount of \$600.00

- ◆ Wholesale Sales Distributor – Maximum of four (4) Licenses issued per year
Distributor retail sales – Maximum of four (4) locations per Wholesale Distributor
- Wholesale Distributor Fee of \$1,500.00
 - Two Money Orders or Checks payable to: Mary Jo Spino, County Clerk
 - One in the amount of \$300.00 (non-refundable)
 - One in the amount of \$1,200.00

APPLICATION, ALL SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION AND FEES ARE DUE **APRIL 29, 2022**

- Clerk reports proposed permits to Legislature **MAY 6, 2022**
- Legislature has 7 days in which to reject all or part **MAY 13, 2022**
- Clerk Issues Permits **MAY 20, 2022**

SEASONAL SALES BEGIN **MAY 21, 2022**

The initial period for wholesale distributor applications ends on April 29, 2022. If fewer than four distributorship licenses are issued, there may be an opportunity for additional applications during the balance of year.
