<b>Jackson County Resident Preference Plan</b>	Enforceable agreements providing residents with opportunities equal to, or greater than those in other cities/counties that publicly fund sports stadiums.	Continuation of current programs, some discounted tickets. Chiefs will limit some benefits to preseason games, if available. No equal to, or greater than, language included.	
<b>Local Presence of Teams</b>	Commitment to keeping front offices, training facilities, and essential operations within Jackson County.	No commitment. Chiefs offer first proposal opportunity to Jackson County but no promise to stay.	
<b>Insurance and Indemnification</b>	Transition insurance responsibilities to the teams by 2025 for taxpayer savings. Taxpayers would save \$10-20 million vs. 2032.	No agreement. County still responsible until new leases (2032).	
<b>Parks Tax Reimbursement</b>	Restoring \$3.5 million annually from parks levy by 2025. Taxpayers would save \$24.5 million vs. 2032.	No agreement. Revenue not returning until new leases (2032).	
<b>Rental Fee</b>	A fair rental/licensing fee, inflation-adjusted, from each team.	No agreement.	
<b>Stadium Demolition</b>	Teams to bear costs, no additional county funds.	Maybe. Teams have agreed that the County will not be responsible, but no commitment or details in LOI.	
<b>Community Benefits Agreements</b>	Enforceable agreements for long-term community benefits.	No agreement.	
<b>Royals' New Stadium Location</b>	Specific location of the Royals' new stadium must be confirmed.	No agreement. "Royals will announce their site selection no later than February 29, 2024."	
<b>Chiefs' Improvement Plans</b>	Detailed plans for Arrowhead improvements and post-Royals relocation vision.	No agreement.	
<b>Private Capital Investment</b>	Teams must commit to the amount of private capital to invest.	No agreement.
