CHAPTER 51

BLASTING

SCOPE

5100. Blasting, Governing Law.

Blasting operations, when conducted anywhere within the corporate limits of Jackson County, shall be governed by the Missouri Blasting Safety Act, sections 319.300-.345, RSMo, this chapter, and any applicable municipal ordinances which are consistent with state law. (Ord. 4311, Eff. 7-11-11)

5101. Blasting, Defined.

Blasting is defined as the use of explosives in mining or construction. (Ord. 4311, Eff. 7-11-11)

5102. <u>Blasting, Prohibition of Excessive Ground Vibrations.</u>

No person, firm, or corporation shall perform any blasting within the County which exceeds the ground vibration limits established by section 319.312, RSMo, as measured pursuant to state law within the unincorporated portion of the County. (Ord. 4311, Eff. 7-11-11)

5103. Blasting, Conditional Use Permit.

The conducting of permitted blasting in the unincorporated portion of the County, pursuant to a conditional use permit, shall be governed by section 24005.15 of this code. (Ord. 4311, Eff. 7-11-11)

5104. Penalty Provision.

The violation of any provision of this chapter may be punished pursuant to section 5520. of this code. (Ord. 4311, Eff. 7-11-11)
